




36 schools in Hamilton, ON stratified by low, middle, and high migrant concentration

1,449 students in grades 5-8, their primary caregiver and teacher

Four primary comparison groups: recent migrant youth (in Canada \leq 5 years); longer-term migrant youth (in Canada > 5 years); 2nd generation migrant youth; and non-migrant youth
